# Children's Classes

## Etiquette

I thought this would be an Ideal time to reinforce Hapkido Etiquette to the Children. Please read below proper Class Etiquette. Etiquette is extremely important part of you training

If you have any queries regarding the Contents please ask you Instructor.

## Bowing:

- Bow when entering & leaving the gym.
- Bow to any visiting black belts before commencement of class.
- Bow to an instructor when leaving or returning to the training area during class.
- If arriving late wait until the instructor bows you in.

## Parents:

- Parents should drop off and pick up their child from inside the Dojang.
- Parents are welcome to stay and watch, but should remain quite and not engage

their child in conversation during class.

## General:

- Arrive 10mins before class start and ensure your ready to start on time.
- Refer to all instructors as SIR.
- Ensure your uniform is kept clean and tidy at all times.
- Advise your instructor of any injuries.
- If you need to leave the mats before the class has ended request the instructors permission.
- Ensure your finger and toenails are kept short.
- Never face the Flags or any Black Belts when fixing uniform.
- Ensure the Dojang is kept clean and tidy at all times.
- When in class and asked a question answer YES or NO sir.
- When asking or answering a question, student should raise their hand and

wait for the instructor to acknowledge.

- NO Swearing or raising your voice in the Dojang.
- NO jewellery to be worn during training.
- Do not lean on walls or slouch around the Dojang.
- Drink water before and at the end of class.
- Treat the Dojang and training equipment with respect at all times.
- Hap Ki Do is a martial art that needs total focus and commitment, so when on the training floor socializing ends and training begins.

The respect, discipline and conduct you develop in Hap Ki Do should not stop once you leave the Dojang.

*Of course, remember that these are valid for all students. Not just the children!!*
